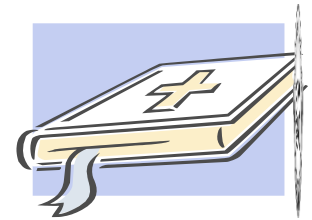

RADIO KERRY: Our regular Parish Mass on Sundays at 10am, will be broadcast live for the duration of the current restrictions.

OPENING OF THE CHURCH: The Church is open for private prayer in accordance with proper public health guidelines. You are very welcome to our church which will be open each day after Mass until 6pm. (except when funeral Masses will be celebrated).

EASTER DUES: envelopes & Easter Newsletters with the accounts for last year are being delivered to all households in the parish. Envelopes and Booklets will also available at the Church doors. Many thanks for your generosity during the year.

EASTER CONFESSIONS: Due to the current restrictions, the usual Penance Service will not take place. **Confessions will be available on Thursday & Saturday next from 3–5pm in the family Chapel.** The priest will be seated behind a Perspex screen. Catholic doctrine teaches that if a person cannot get to Confession, it is sufficient to confess one's sins to God, seeking forgiveness and with the intention of going to confession when next possible. God forgives the sins and the person is renewed in heart and soul. When the opportunity then arises later to go to Confession, he or she should do so.
