



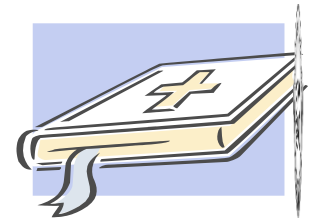

**PUBLIC MASSES:** We are delighted to have a congregation back to Mass even with limited numbers. These past few months have been a difficult time without public Masses and without our experience of a worshipping community. Once again it will be a very different experience to attend Mass with smaller numbers and social distancing. We ask for your understanding and patience as we put safety measures in place. Some people may not feel comfortable in attending Mass. The obligation to attend Mass on Sundays continues to be lifted.

Mass will be celebrated each day from Monday to Saturday at 9.30am. Weekend Masses on Saturday at 6.30pm and Sunday at 10am, 11.15am & 12.30pm. There will not be a booking system, just first come first served. We encourage people to observe all the safety protocols.

**TELEVISED MASS:** on SKY channel 521 or on RTE News Channel, will be broadcast from our church this Thursday June 10th at 10.30am.

**RADIO KERRY:** Our regular Parish Mass on Sundays at 10am, will be broadcast live for the duration of the current restrictions.
