



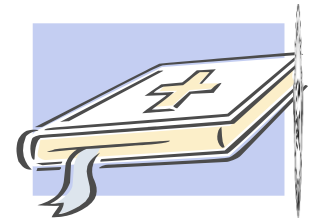

PUBLIC MASSES: While it is great to be back to public Masses, we have noticed that the numbers attending have increased over the past weeks. Unfortunately we have had to close the doors at Masses at weekends and to turn people away. This is very difficult for those wishing to attend Mass as well as for the ushers.

While the Church is spacious, we are bound by the current government guidelines in the interest of public safety.

Once again we are asking people who can attend the daily Masses to do so, and to leave the spaces at weekend Masses for families and for workers. The obligation to attend Mass on Sundays continues to be lifted.

Mass will be celebrated each day from Monday to Saturday at 9.30am. Weekend Masses on Saturday at 6.30pm and Sunday at 10am, 11.15am & 12.30pm. There will not be a booking system, just first come, first served. We encourage people to observe all the safety protocols.

RADIO KERRY: Our regular Parish Mass on Sundays at 10am, will be broadcast live for the duration of the current restrictions.

PARISH OFFICE: is open from 9.00am to 12.30pm.

MASS BOOKINGS: Sometimes people provisionally book a Mass, then decide not to go ahead with it but forget to cancel it with the Parish Office. This is frustrating for people trying unsuccessfully to book Masses. It would be helpful if you have provisionally booked a Mass to confirm the booking in the Parish Office with the Mass Offering: Otherwise we can offer the Mass to another family. Many thanks.

INTRODUCTION TO THE READINGS THIS WEEKEND

First Reading: Jeremiah's prophetic message reflects the manner in which the past and the present enable us to live in God's future now.

Second Reading: Christ Jesus is the peace, good news and reconciliation for all people.

Gospel: Jesus the shepherd-leader shows us how to lead, protect, guide and serve God's people with courage and sacrifice.
