



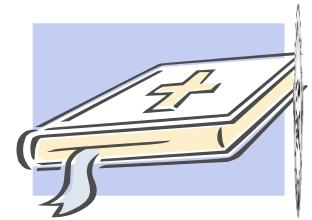

**PUBLIC MASSES:** While it is great to be back to  
public Masses, we have noticed that the numbers  
attending have increased over the past two weeks.  
Unfortunately we have had to close the doors at  
Mass last weekend and to turn people away. This is  
very difficult for those wishing to attend Mass as  
well as for the ushers.

While the Church is spacious, we are bound by the  
current government guidelines in the interest of  
public safety.

Once again we are asking people who can attend  
the daily Masses to do so, and to leave the spaces  
at weekend Masses for families and for workers.  
The obligation to attend Mass on Sundays continues  
to be lifted.

Mass will be celebrated each day from Monday to  
Saturday at 9.30am. Weekend Masses on Saturday  
at 6.30pm and Sunday at 10am, 11.15am &  
12.30pm. There will not be a booking system, just  
first come, first served. We encourage people to  
observe all the safety protocols.

**CONFIRMATION CONGRATS:** Congratulations to  
the boys and girls of Holy Family and Listellick  
Schools who were confirmed this week. Many  
thanks to their teachers and parents who helped  
prepare them for the sacrament.

**BAPTISMS:** We are now taking bookings for  
Baptisms, please contact the Parish Office.

**PYX:** A pyx is a small container which is used to  
bring holy communion to the housebound or to the  
sick. If you have been given one to use and no  
longer need it, please return it to the Parish Office

**FIRST COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION CEREMONIES:** Given  
the high level of vaccinations and the easing of restrictions, it is  
hoped to have the ceremonies on the publicised dates during  
September. Each child will be allowed to have only 2 family  
members in the church. All ceremonies will be live streamed. The  
ceremonies, which have been prepared in co-operation with the  
teachers, will be shorter and simpler. We encourage all families  
to show due care and caution regarding household gatherings.
