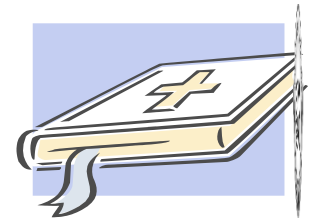

5. People are welcome to sit in any seat they wish but we ask you to show due regard for others.
