



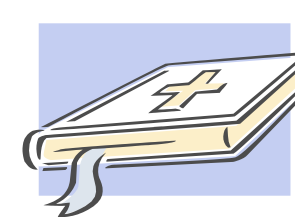

**PUBLIC MASSES:** We welcome the recent announcement that we can have 100% capacity at all Masses. As more people return to Mass, we encourage all people to be mindful of people who are just returning to Mass after many months. Please wear a mask in the church.

1. All doors will be in use.

3. The collection boxes inside the doors will continue to be used instead of having an Offertory Collection.
4. We encourage people to come forward for Holy Communion row-by-row and to receive on the hand only.

**RADIO KERRY:** Our regular Parish Mass on Sundays at 10am, will be broadcast live.

**THE ADVENT WREATH;** is part of our Catholic tradition going back to the Middle Ages. The circle of the wreath, which has no beginning or end, symbolises the eternity of God. The four candles represent the four weeks of Advent, three purple signifying penance, and one rose signifying joy. The white candle is lit on Christmas Eve and Christmas Day reminding Christians that Jesus is the light of the world.

**THE JESSE TREE;** is the family tree of Jesus. It traces His family through the Old Testament. The Jesse Tree emphasises the true meaning of Christmas, the birth of Jesus Christ.
