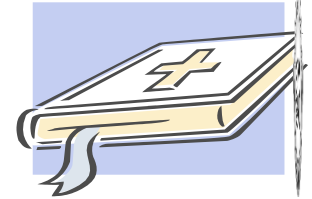

First Reading

Paul & Barnabas engage in a central pastoral task: they urge people to remain faithful to the grace of God - even in times of difficulty and misunderstanding.

Second

The victory of heaven is immense: John sees 'a huge number, impossible to count,' who have been faithful in persecution and hardship.

Gospel

The Lord describes his sheep, his followers, as people who listen to his voice. There is no discipleship without attentive listening.
