



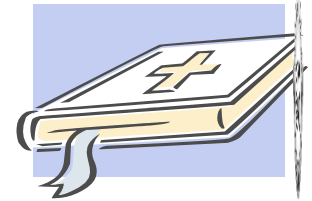

INTRODUCTION TO THE READINGS THIS WEEKEND

First Reading

The prophet Malachi exhorts people to live out of a sense of expectation; neither lax indifference nor paralysing fear of what is to come are appropriate stances for God's faithful. The time of judgement will be the time when God's faithful are vindicated.

Second Reading

It may be that some of the people Paul was addressing were so taken up with expectation regarding the Lord's return that they thought there was no point in doing any work. A fine theological justification for laziness! Paul exhorts believers to be alert, purposeful and industrious, and to avoid anxious speculation about the future.

Gospel

"When will this be?" The disciples are keen to put dates on God's future deeds, but Jesus urges them to look to themselves: they are to be ready to witness to Jesus with courage, in the knowledge that their perseverance will be rewarded.
