

INTRODUCTION TO THE READINGS THIS WEEKEND

First Reading:

The prophet Isaiah is at pains to make it clear that what pleases worship that is accompanied by a life that sees and responds to the needs of others.

Second Reading:

In holding a question mark over the usefulness of philosophy, St Paul is insisting that faith itself is pure gift, and not the product of human ingenuity.

Gospel:

In calling his disciples the salt of the earth and the light of the world, Jesus is telling us that an authentic life of faith will impact on others, will be noticed, will make a difference. There is no such thing as a purely personal, private hidden faith.
