

Peter, it seems, is impressed at the marvellous company Jesus is keeping in this mountain-top scene. But the voice of the Father God's revelation, corrects his understanding. After hearing Gods voice, the attention of Peter, James and John is focussed entirely on Jesus: 'they saw no one but only Jesus.
