



INTRODUCTION TO THE READINGS THIS WEEKEND

First Reading: It would not be long before the infant church felt the winds of persecution, but this reading from the Acts of the Apostles describes the Church's honeymoon, a time of unity, joy and peace.

Second Reading: If we seek a truly Christian 'mantra' for this Easter season, we need look no further than the first line of this reading: 'Blessed be God the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ'.

Gospel: The first word of the risen Jesus is 'peace'. Then he shows his disciples the wounds through which he has secured that peace. He then appoints the disciples to mission, giving them the power of his Spirit.
