



INTRODUCTION TO THE READINGS THIS WEEKEND

First Reading

The earliest roots of the Eucharist lie in the sacrifices offered to God by his people Israel. But now, it is the Lord who gives himself to us.

Second Reading

The letter of the Hebrews shows that Christ is the fulfilment and the perfection of all the earlier sacrifices. The blood of animals was once used to restore people to holiness; but now, it is the blood of Christ himself that is shed for us.

Gospel

At the supper, Jesus took some bread, he blessed it, broke it and gave it. These four actions, taking, blessing, breaking and giving, are central to every celebration of the Eucharist.
