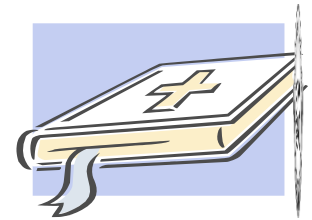

### **First Reading**

We can expect to be challenged by prophets like Isaiah and John the Baptist. God has, after all, made their speech like a sharp sword.
