



### First Reading

We can expect to be challenged by prophets like Isaiah and John the Baptist. God has, after all, made their speech like a sharp sword.

Second Reading

John the Baptist was mentioned in the earliest Christian preaching: he heralded Christ and knew that he himself was a humble servant of the Messiah.
