



Pope Francis will officially open the year by opening a Holy Door in St Peter's Basilica, Rome on Christmas Eve. The beginning of the Jubilee Year will be celebrated worldwide on the following weekend on he Feast Day of the Holy Family in every diocese worldwide, and at all our Masses that weekend. Pope Francis has chosen the Jubilee theme "Pilgrims of Hope".

We are asked to treat the year ahead as a year-long pilgrimage seeking together to become more aware that truly Jesus Christ Our Saviour is with us each day, - as our help, strength and guide.
