



INTRODUCTION TO THE READINGS THIS WEEKEND

First Reading

In the presence of God's glory, Isaiah feels sinful, unclean. But once he has experienced forgiveness, Isaiah is ready and willing to be God's messenger, willing to accept his calling as a prophet.

Second Reading

Paul urges the Corinthians to be steadfast in believing the Gospel he has preached to them. There will always be temptations to turn to right or to left, but we are called to perseverance in the truth.

Gospel

At the heart of this Gospel reading are St Peter's wonderful words. He is tired and despondent, yet he says to the Lord: 'If you say so....'
