

## INTRODUCTION TO THE READINGS THIS WEEKEND

#### First Reading

David shows mercy to someone who had sought to harm him. Mercy is not a generic, spineless matter: it is a concrete decision in favour of those who have not shown one favour.

Second Reading

St Paul finds it useful to draw comparisons and contrasts between the sinful Adam and the sinless Christ. Indeed, he 'nicknames' Jesus 'the last Adam.' In Adam, sin had the first word, but in Christ, sinlessness has the last.

Gospel

There is only one way Jesus can have spoken these words with conviction: he was convinced of the love of God the Father. Only those who know they are loved by God can find the wherewithal to love those who do not love them.
