



**PUBLIC MASSES:** As announced last week, it is with delight that we announce the return of Public Masses from this Monday with limited numbers. These past few months have been a difficult time without public Masses and without our experience of a congregation. Once again it will be a very different experience to attend Mass with smaller numbers and social distancing. We ask for your patience and understanding as we put safety measures in place. Some people may not feel comfortable in attending Mass. The obligation to attend Mass on Sundays continues to be lifted.

Mass will be celebrated this week each day from Monday to Saturday at 9.30am.  
Weekend Masses on Saturday at 6.30pm and Sunday at 10am, 11.15am & 12.30pm.  
There will not be a booking system, just first come, first served. We encourage people to observe all the safety protocols.

**RADIO KERRY:** Our regular Parish Mass on Sundays at 10am will be broadcast for the duration of the current restrictions.

**BAPTISMS:** We will be taking bookings for baptisms from Monday next, May 10th.
